Good Reasons to be Socially Active and Maintain a good and Healthy Attitude

Older age, the onset of depression and increased loneliness can significantly contribute to the risk of dementia and cognitive decline, according to two separate studies.

In the first study, published recently in BMC Psychiatry, South Korean researchers investigated the relationship between age at the onset of depression and Alzheimer's disease risk. They followed a group of251 older adults over a 22-year period; major depressive disorders were diagnosed in them at various ages: less than 54, 55 to 64, 65 to 74 and over 75 years.

The researchers found that the onset of depression after age 75 was strongly associated with an increased risk of Alzheimer's disease and a shorter time to dementia onset compared with the other groups. The older individuals also had less severe depressive symptoms but a higher prevalence of hypertension and cerebro vascular disease than those in whom depression was diagnosed before age 55.

The authors said that depression onset after age 75 may result from preexisting brain damage or neuro degeneration. Their findings, they added, support mounting evidence suggesting that cerebro vascular disease and hypertension contribute to an increased amyloid burden in the brain, potentially linking late-life depression to Alzheimer's-related changes in the brain.

"Our study suggests that the age of 75 years may serve as an important indicator for distinguishing between early- and late-onset depression, as dementia risk increases significantly beyond this age, "they wrote. "Although 65 years of age is typically used to define older adulthood, our study supports the evidence that significant neuropsychiatric changes, including increased Alzheimer's disease risk, may occur around the age of 75 years."

Given their findings, the researchers suggested that factors influencing dementia risk may differ between individuals who have depression before and after age 75. They said that future research should focus on identifying distinct risk factors that examine pathways linking depression and dementia in individuals with depression onset before or after age 75.

Changes in loneliness, social isolation affect dementia risk

In the second study, published recently in the International Journal of Geriatric Psychiatry, Australian researchers from Monash University examined the effects of changes in loneliness, social isolation and social support on dementia risk and cognitive decline.

They identified gender-specific associations between social connection measures and the risk of dementia/cognitive decline over the eight-year study period. Specifically, the investigators found that persistent loneliness in people aged 70 or more years, especially in women, was associated with a higher risk of dementia and cognitive decline. The study used data from more than 12,000 Australian older adults.

Over time, compared with the never-lonely group, incident (new-onset) loneliness in men was associated with a 52% increased risk of dementia, whereas persistent loneliness in women was associated with a 114% increased risk of dementia.

By examining changes in social connections, the researchers concluded that new-onset loneliness in men and persistent loneliness in women both were associated with a greater risk of dementia among adults aged 70 or more years.

Early identification of poor social connections, particularly loneliness, and timely intervention to prevent its progression into a chronic state, may help older adults maintain cognitive resilience while also delaying cognitive decline and dementia onset, they concluded.
